

Winter Activities Program Conduct Agreement

Please carefully read all of the rules of acceptable conduct for the Winter Activities Program. *Parents and student should review all of the rules together* and ask for clarification if there is any confusion.

We are a very large group, so it is extremely important that the rules of acceptable conduct be followed at all times. **Failure to comply with any of the rules is cause for a student to be removed from the program for a period of one week to the rest of the sessions.** If a student is removed from the program, he/she will forfeit any fees paid and will not receive a refund. Removal from the program is at the discretion of the Winter Activities Director and that decision is final.

Rules of Conduct

1. Participants must be properly equipped for extreme weather conditions. This includes having gloves/mittens; helmet (or rental helmet); neck protection; sunscreen; sunglasses/goggles; waterproof coat, pants and/or ski suit; warm socks. An extra pair of gloves or mittens doesn't hurt should the first pair get wet.
2. Participants must have a sack lunch or money to purchase lunch.
3. Each participant must wear a helmet at all times while skiing or snowboarding.
4. If a student fails to be back at the bus for the departure back to Fairplay at 2:15 P.M., he/she will not be permitted to attend the next session.
5. **Students will NOT be permitted to leave the ski area, be left at the ski area and picked up by a parent, or be taken home by a friend's parent without written permission from his/her own parent. If this mandate is not followed, the student will not be allowed to attend the following week and will forfeit any fees paid.**
6. Participants will use appropriate language at all times, be respectful to others, and will follow the directions of supervisors, ski/ride instructors, chaperones, and bus drivers.
