_____ Skiers: Can make parallel turns on all green terrain. Can start turns with a slight wedge and finish with skis parallel on blue terrain. Can make a hockey stop.

_____ Snowboarders: Can link turns confidently on all green terrain. Can link turns most of the time on groomed blue terrain.

Adult volunteers take a group of 4 to 6 kids after lunch until 2:00 P.M. and supervise their free ski/ride time. They are responsible for getting their group **back ON the bus by 2:15 P.M.**

Volunteers also help load lunch baskets; hand out and put away boots, boards, and skis; help kids attach their tickets; etc.

We have a cap of twenty complimentary tickets a week. Depending on the number of adults who volunteer, you may not get a ticket every week.

If you do not ski or ride, we also need adults to help stay with "sick and sad" kids in the restaurant or supervise beginners on the magic carpet before they learn to ride the lift.

All volunteers must have a background check submitted through Park County School District. (If you submitted one in the last few years with the school you do not need an additional one.) Forms will be available in each school office. You will need to go to the sheriff's office to be fingerprinted and return the completed form to the school administration office with a check to PCSD for \$40 (cost of CBI processing). This takes a minimum of six weeks.
